

WEEE DIRECTIVE POLICY STATEMENT

The WEEE Directive (Waste Electrical and Electronic Directive) commenced in the UK on 1st July 2007. The WEEE Directive aims to:-

- Minimise the disposal of WEEE as unsorted municipal waste and achieve a high level of collection of WEEE for treatment, recovery and environmentally sound disposal.
- Improve the environmental performance of all those involved in the life cycle of electrical and electronic equipment.

Some EEE can contain substances that are potentially hazardous to the environment and human health and must be disposed of in an environmentally acceptable manner. The WEEE directive ensures that the appropriate treatment is available for such EEE.

- With effect from July 1st 2007 when buying new Birchwood Price Tools (BPT) branded product , BPT will recycle historic product on a one for one and like for like basis. Historic Product is product purchased before 13th August 2005.
- With effect from 1st July 2007 BPT will provide end of life recycling for its products purchased since 13th August 2005.

Birchwood Price Tools WEEE Business (B2B) Solution

For business customers who only require a recycling solution for their BPT branded obsolete electrical equipment BPT will provide this service free of charge once this equipment has been received at the nominated collection facility.

BPT will be responsible for the removal and treatment of product received at our nominated collection facility.

Once we have all the necessary information you will be advised of a delivery location to which the obsolete product should be transported at your expense.

BPT WEEE registration number is WEE/HC0042SY. This means that BPT is a registered producer under the UK Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2007.
